EXPLANATION: A+ STUDENTS MUST SIGN AN A+ AGREEMENT AND CITIZENSHIP GUIDELINE PRIOR TO HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION. Signatures on the <i>A+ Agreement</i> and <i>A+ Citizenship</i> forms show that a student is enrolled and participating in the A+ Program.	
GHS Enrollment/Entry Date (Please read the following explanation)	
EXPLANATION: A+ STUDENTS MUST ATTEND A MISSOURI A+ DESIGNATED SCHOOL FOR THE LAST THREE CONSECUTIVE YEARS PRIOR TO GRADUATION. If the student has attended a high school other than Glendale, the A+ Office will request records from those schools to determine whether the student meets this criterion.	
Cumulative Non-Weighted GPA	
EXPLANATION: A+ STUDENTS MUST HAVE A CUMULATIVE, 4-YEAR 2.5/4.0 NON-WEIGHTED GPA. The non-weighted GPA on this report is the student's GPA through the student's last completed term/semester. The student's cumulative N/W GPA at the end of their senior year will be used to determine final A+ eligibility.	
Cumulative Attendance	
EXPLANATION: A+ STUDENTS MUST MAINTAIN A CUMULATIVE, 4-YEAR ATTENDANCE RECORD OF AT LEAST 95%. The student's cumulative attendance at the end of their senior year is used to determine final A+ eligibility. The average above reflects GHS attendance only--attendance at other high schools will be requested/included in determining A+ eligibility. You may call or e-mail the A+ Office at any time for updated averages.	
Tutoring Hours to Date	
EXPLANATION: A+ STUDENTS MUST PERFORM 50 HOURS OF UNPAID, SCHOOL-BASED ACADEMIC TUTORING If this area is blank, it indicates that the student has <i>no tutoring hours or is currently enrolled</i> . It is recommended that students working for A+ eligibility enroll in the Tutoring class two times during the junior and/or senior years to log the 50 hours required by the A+ Schools Program. There may be a limited number of after-school or summer school opportunities available—check with the A+ Office for details and availability.	
Citizenship Compliance (see the following Explanation)	
EXPLANATION: A+ STUDENTS MUST DEMONSTRATE CITIZENSHIP COMPLIANCE DURING ALL 4 YEARS OF HIGH SCHOOL. Due to confidentiality, individual student citizenship compliance is not included in this report – please call the A+ Coordinator if you have questions. Good citizenship, as established by the Program, is a measure of the quality of conduct both in school and away from school . Disciplinary infractions that occur during the 9 th , 10 th , and 11 th grade year place a student on probationary status. It is expected that students who are out of compliance demonstrate a pattern of improvement in order to be removed from probationary status. It is an expectation of the A+ Program that students have zero disciplinary infractions during the senior year .	
As mandated by State Regulation 5 CSR 50-350.040, a student must maintain a record of avoidance of the unlawful use of drugs and/or alcohol. A student will forfeit the opportunity to earn A+ Schools financial incentives for any alcohol and/or drug violation committed at any time throughout the four years the student attends high school.
