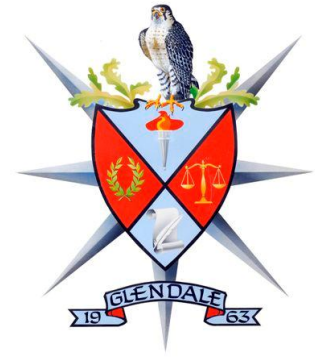

The Falcon Fund Purpose and Philosophy:

The Falcon Fund was established by faculty, alumni, parents, and students on the 35th anniversary of Glendale High School to provide additional financial resources for educational enrichment. Through private donations and/or deferred gifts, The Falcon Fund will assist in answering the educational needs of Glendale High School students.

The Falcon Fund Mission Statement:

The Falcon Fund is dedicated to ensuring that Glendale students have opportunities and resources available to meet their individual educational needs.

Description of Fund:

The annual fund will be used to assist GHS students to further their educational experiences. Glendale staff members may also request funds to advance the educational opportunities of their students. A committee of Glendale faculty, alumni, and parents of alumni will execute decisions on the granting of funds.

Criteria for Application:

Students receiving grants must:

- Attend Glendale High School.
- Maintain good citizenship as set forth by the Springfield Public Schools Citizenship Standards.
- Exhibit interest in expanding his or her academic, athletic, artistic, or leadership pursuits.
- Financial considerations or alternative sources of funding may be used in determining grant requests.

Application Process:

- Applications may be generated by either students or staff.
- Applications may be filed with the Allocations Chairperson at any time throughout the calendar year.
- Applications will be reviewed and acted upon by the Allocations Committee.
- No monies will be paid directly to the recipient.

Examples of funded opportunities:

- Grants will be made to increase the educational opportunities in academics, fine arts, leadership, and athletics.
- Summer camps, clinics, trips, enrichment or remedial programs, or special events which expand the student's knowledge within a field of study or refine a talent/skill.
- Other opportunities of a personal nature (prom attire, graduation robes, work or interview clothing,) may be funded at the discretion of the Allocations Committee.
- Dual enrollment for students with financial hardships.
- Public bus transportation.
