# Mrs. Reece's 3rd Grade News

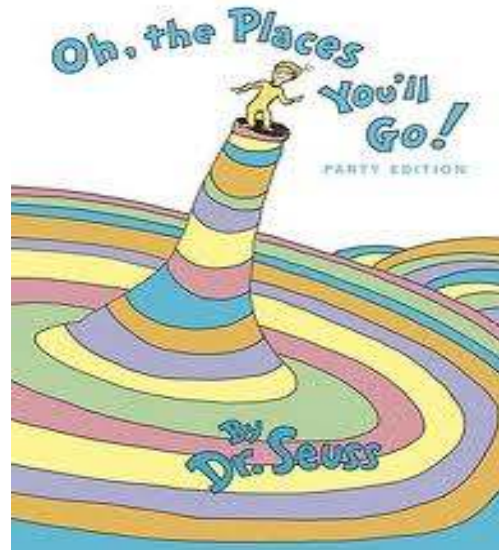
## Helpful Hints/Materials Needed:
