

## FUTURE FALCONS BASKETBALL PROGRAM

### A Focus on Skill and Player Development

Dear Parents,

I started the Future Falcons Basketball Program this past year in order to provide an affordable skills and player development program to ALL boys and girls in the 4th through incoming 9th grade at the feeder schools for Glendale. I hoped that we might have 20 families interested in such a program. There have been as many as 108 kids involved so far.

The program is a year round program. The hope is that the boys and girls who join as 4th graders will then stay with the program until they are headed to high school in August of their 9th grade year. I believe that if they do this, then they will have made great progress and will be able to enjoy basketball for a lifetime.

The Future Falcons Program is not an AAU or traveling organization. Instead, the staff focuses on SKILL development and TEAM development every week. The members are invited to be at both sessions every week. The members are also invited to join age appropriate teams at The Courts. However, participation in the leagues is optional. Members can choose to simply attend the weekly sessions. No matter what members choose to do and no matter how many sessions or games they can attend, they always receive the full energy of the staff.

What sets us apart from other programs? FIRST, there is no pressure if a member must miss a session or a game. They do not "lose their place." SECOND, a member may join the program at anytime. THIRD, as stated before, the program is affordable. The monthly program fee is \$45.00 per player. This works out to a little over 5.00 per session and when you add games, it works out to around 3.00 per interaction with our staff. Some programs currently cost as much as \$200.00 to \$300.00 per month. In my opinion, that is unreasonable.
